The Faculty Executive Committee proposethe following changes to the membership description of the three committees listed below:

a. COMMITTEE ON EDUCATIONAL POLICIES & PLANNING (CEPP) Elected

Function: To recommend to the Faculty and hodistration short-and long-range educational plans for the College and thus be instrumed int clarifying, improving and changing major policies and educational procedur to evaluate Skidmore's sent practices and goals. The Chair of CEPP shall sit on the IPPC. The CEPP transpare to the pursuit of its functions, with the appropriate of the Board of Trustees.

Membership [Six] Five faculty members, two of whom must be tenuted from a different department, and with at least one member from each four Divisions of Disciplines, elected to serve three-year terms. Dean of the Faculty/Vice sident for Academic Affairs or his/her designated representative; the Defastudent Affairs or his/her designated representative; and two students selected A.SCEPP may appoint such subcommittees from among its members or from the College community rate as it deems help to facilitate its work.

b. CURRICULUM COMMITTEE (CC) Elected

Function: To act for the Faculty reviewing curricular matters including those which implement educational policy concerning all-College prizements; to generate recommendations concerning immediate and long-range curricular ters; to make recommendations to the Faculty concerning other curricular matters utght before it by factly, students, and the Administration.

Membership [Six] Five faculty members [each from a different department] least two of whom are tenured with at least one member from each four Divisions of Disciplines, elected to serve three-year terms Dean of the Faculty/Vice sident for Academic Affairs or his/her designated representationed two students selected SGA. Non-voting members of the committee are the Registrar, and the Association of the Faculty for Academic Policy and Advising.

c. MASTERS OF ARTS IN LIBERAL STUDIES COMMITTEE (MALS) Elected

Function: To participate in all aspects of the data of Arts in Liberal Studies (MALS) Program by determining academic policies and procedures, admitting and dismissing students, approving

core seminars, approving degree plans and **piraje**ct proposals, making recommendations for degrees, and recommending faculty selection aptrophic on all matters administrative policy and to assist in the further direction of the program.

Membership[Four] Two faculty members, each representing one of the four Divisions of Disciplines, elected to server terms; and one library culty member, appointed in consultation with the Director of the MALS Pragn and the College Librarian to serve a three-year term; the Dean of Special Programs, the Deathe Faculty/Vice President for Academic Affairs or his/her designeend the Director and Academ A
